

Guidelines for poster presenters

- On the [SCCER Intranet](#) we provide a Power Point template and content structure for your poster. We suggest that you use the template, but feel free to adapt as it better fits your needs. Please keep in any case the logos and basic layout that allows the participants to rapidly identify SCCER Mobility work.
- The title of your poster should appear at the top of your poster, below the red line, it should be at least 2.54 cm high. Below the title place the authors' names and affiliations. (You can use the fonts provided in the template, they would be big enough if printed in A0).
- **Remember:** The flow of your poster should be as clear as possible, we suggest from the top left to the bottom right. And make your poster as self-explanatory as possible, so that you will have time for in-depth technical discussions and exchange with the other SCCER Mobility members.
- For a good result using the template, you should export the document as a A3-pdf and then print it to A0-size. (118.9 cm high x 84.1 cm wide).
- Please do not forget to **register and upload your poster until 31 August 2017** on the dedicated [intranet space](#) or by e-mail to fiorella.meyer@sccer.ethz.ch only poster uploaded by that date will eligible for the "Best Poster Award".
- **"Best Poster Award"** will be granted during the Annual Conference. The 6 pre-selected researchers will have the opportunity to present their poster in a 3-minutes presentation (poster pitch) during the Annual Conference.
- The poster board is self-standing and will be marked with the code of the capacity area, which the poster belongs to. Push-pins will be provided.
- The **poster session** will take place in the ML building, Turbinenhalle (next to the Auditorium)
